General Disaster Rules	
The Disaster	General Rules to Follow
Tornado	Move residents to any area with four walls and no windows, such as:      * Hallways     * Bathrooms
	Stay away from windows.
	Use pillows for protection from flying objects.
	Close resident room doors as well as fire and safety doors.
	Pull drapes across windows.
Hurricane	You may be required to evacuate the residence.
	If so, help residents pack <b>essential</b> items, such as medications.
	(If evacuation is not required, follow the rules for tornadoes.)
Flood	Remove residents from below ground or ground floor rooms.
	Keep residents sheltered in above ground rooms.
	Keep residents away from windows and doors.
Heavy Snow or Blizzard	Do not let residents go outside until the snow has been shoveled.
	<ul> <li>Ensure proper clothing such as boots, hats, and gloves.</li> </ul>
	Limit the time that a resident is outside.
Earthquake	Help residents to doorways or onto the floor. Bring blankets and pillows for protection and comfort.
	<ul> <li>Know the location and contents of the earthquake emergency box which contains flashlights, batteries, a portable radio, and first- aid supplies.</li> </ul>
Power Outage	Know where the flashlights are.
	<ul> <li>Move residents into a common area such as a dining room or activities room.</li> </ul>
